## **One New Infrastructure Stock Added; Three Stocks Deleted from S-Network Emerging Infrastructure Builders Index in Quarterly Rebalancing**

(New York, March 10, 2009) The S-Network Emerging Infrastructure Builders Index<sup>SM</sup> (TICKER: EIBI) will add one new component, effective 09:00 AM (EST) Monday March 23, 2009. Three stocks will be deleted from the index, changing the number of index components to 60. The changes result from the quarterly rebalancing of the index.
