

Rule for the S-Network Emerging Infrastructure Builders IndexSM Revised for Country Qualification

New York, NY, January 4, 2011 -- The [S-Network Emerging Infrastructure Builders IndexSM](http://www.snetinfrastructureindex.com) (TICKER: EIBI) Committee has revised the country qualification rules for construction of the Index.

To date, the Index has defined eligible “Emerging Market” countries as being “non-OECD” members. Henceforth, eligible “Emerging Market” countries will be defined as “Middle Income” countries, using the World Bank Country Classification System. The World Bank defines a Middle Income country as having per capita Gross National Income (GNI) of between USD 996 p.a. and USD 12,195 p.a.

The S-Network Emerging Infrastructure Builders IndexSM is a capitalization-weighted, float-adjusted index of the most prominent infrastructure stocks from developing and middle-income countries, plus a limited number of developed market stocks with extensive emerging markets operations. To be included in the EIBI index, stocks must pass multiple screens, including for capitalization, float, exchange listing, share price and turnover.
